Courtesy visit by OUI Inc. to universities and hospitals in Indonesia

In August 2022, OUI Inc. had a courtesy visit to several universities and hospitals in Indonesia, the site of the Smart Eye Camera project.



At Hasanuddin University, we had a meeting to discuss future joint research and started test use of Smart Eye Camera. We have also greeted the Dean and Vice Dean of Faculty of Medicine of Hasanuddin University and established a joint structure for the future.

At Udayana University (UNUD) and Sanglah Central General Hospital in Bali, we had a meeting for joint research using Smart Eye Camera, checked the progress, and started test use of the device. UNUD is the largest public hospital and teaching hospital in Bali. We also participated in a free eye camp (eye examination and surgery) with Professor Bill Morgan (Managing director of the Lions Eye Institute, and Professor of Ophthalmology at the University of Western Australia) of the John Fawcett Foundation, which has been supporting eye care in Bali for 20 years, together with Udayana University. Dr. Shimizu and Mr. Nakayama visited Harapan Kita Women and Children Hospital (HKWCH) in Jakarta, to follow up on a joint research project using Smart Eye Camera. Smart Eye Camera was used in pilot at HKWCH in many different scenarios, such as screening of the anterior segment of the eye in newborn babies in the ICU (intensive care unit), fundus examination for retinopathy of prematurity, and observation of the optic nerve.

We will continue to collaborate with various universities and hospitals to reduce blindness in the world while providing evidence.
